QUESTION & ANSWER

Captain Andre is the Managing Director of STET Maritime Pte Ltd. He has been instrumental in leading the Company to become a leading Recognized Security Organization to act on behalf of the Panama Maritime Authority for the approval of ship security plans and conduct of security verification audit for the compliance of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), International Ship & Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code for Panama flag vessels.

Captain Andre has been involved in the development of Supply Chain Security management system for shipping companies including its security profiling for compliance with U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP), Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) criteria.

Captain Andre was the project director and consultant for the development of the National Supply Chain Security Programme which has been named as Secure Trade Partnership (STP) programme and now headed by the Singapore Customs. He was also involved in ISO 28000 on Supply Chain Security Management System with International Standard Organisation (ISO) Technical Committee (TC/8) and had written a book titled "A Practitioner's Definitive Guide to Safety and Security" for the Singapore Logistic Association.

Capt Andre was also a member of a working group for the International Labour Organisation (ILO) on the Maritime Labour Convention 2006 (MLC) and a qualified chief instructor for the ILO Port Development Program.

Over the past years, Capt.Andre had been involved in conducting seminars and workshop covering a wide range of topics from maritime security to port development programs for various organization including Japan's Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MLIT), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and Organization of American States (OAS) to name a few. Capt.Andre had also been involved with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) as a resource person and consultant to the various workgroup in the Brunei Darussalam-Indonesia-Malaysia-The Philippines—East ASEAN Growth Area (BIMP-EAGA). Capt. Andre is also an IMO consultant and have been engaged by IMO on various capacity building projects.

Prior to joining STET, Captain Andre was involved in maritime, nautical, training and seafaring matters since 1980 where he started his sea going career with A.P.Moller Maersk. He worked through the ranks and received his first command as Master in 1994 onboard a panamax bulk carrier in an established shipping company. Captain Andre have command experience onboard a bulk carrier, car carrier and container vessel

Subsequently, he assumed various appointments, both ashore and at sea within the same company including conducting port and cargo logistic operation before establishing and heading the Safety and Training Department where he co-ordinate and conduct internal and external audit of company and its affiliates, shipboard audit, verification inspection, training courses and seminars, investigation of vessel casualty, pollution incidents, stowaways and cargo damage. He was also involved in Hull and Machinery underwriters, Protection and Indemnity Insurance and Cargo Underwriters survey work.

Capt. Andre is a Master Mariner, certified Maritime Lead Auditor with the International Register of Certificated Auditors (IRCA) and holds a Master of Science degree from Singapore National Technical University and Bachelor of Science degree from Alabama USA. He was also trained as an OPA-90 "Qualified Individual" from Massachusetts Maritime Academy, International Marine Emergency Response Centre. Capt. Andre is also the Regional Director of the International Institute of Marine Surveyors and Member of the Singapore Nautical Institute.
